Vocation Promotion and Formation:

- Considering the current situation, the decision of the IMV is to suspend this year the intake of class 10 completed students but +2 completed or above are welcomed to join this year as aspirants but they will remain in the communities of their respective region till the normal situation for travel is established.
- The promoted aspirants of this year are asked to complete the +2 studies at home due to the Covid 19 situation. They will continue their status as aspirants and will be accompanied by the communities of their respective region. The director of formation and vocation promoter will co-ordinate the exact details of formation accompaniment of these aspirants

along with the community superiors of the respective aspirants.

- Candidates of philosophy at Warangal have started the online classes.
- Scholastics of second and third year theology of Shillong community started the academic year residing at Oriens Theology College. The first year of theology is scheduled to begin by September 2020.
- The Aspirancy formation program in Bangalore community has not begun

this year as the vocation promotion is affected. The community comprises only with few formators.

- As the candidates of spiritual orientation have not reached at Chullikkara due to travel restrictions, currently the community is left with only two formators. They are asked to reach to the nearest communities of their region till they are able to travel safe to Chullikkara.
