#### BEATIFICATION FUNCTION OF FATHER FRANCIS JORDAN

The IMV will virtually participate the ceremony of the beatification of our Founder on May 15, 2021 livestreaming. The communities of each region with Salvatorian Sisters and Lay Salvatorians have made arrangement to come together on May 15 as far as possible for the ceremony. The celebration of thanksgiving Eucharist presided over by Bishop/representative of Bishop in honouring the gift of Blessed Francis Jordan will be organised by communities of each region with the collaboration of Salvatorians sisters and Lay preferably on July 21 or the days convenient adhering to the Government Covid protocols.

#### INFORMATION ON THE BEATIFICATION



In 1942, the cause for the Beatification of Father Francis Jordan was opened. In January 2011, the Holy Father, Pope Benedict XVI, signed the Decree of Venerability. During the ordinary session of the Cardinals and Bishops of the Congregation for the Causes of Saints on 19 June 2020, the miracle attributed to the intercession of Father Francis Jordan was recognized, approved and promulgated by the Holy Father, Pope Francis. This act defined the beatification of Father Francis Jordan setting the date for the celebration as 15 May 2021.

Finally, the day long awaited by all members of the Salvatorian Family has arrived: The Beatification of Father Francis Jordan. His charism is to help the Church to know, love and proclaim the one God manifested in Jesus Christ, the Divine Saviour. Today, this is the true inspiration for many Salvatorian women and men, religious and lay, who work following the example of the apostles in more than 50 countries, scattered in the different continents: Europe, America, Asia, Australia and Africa working in the field of education, evangelization, human and spiritual promotion, in missions and parish ministry.

#### YEAR OF THANKSGIVING FOR BLESSED FRANCIS JORDAN 2021-21JULY-2022

It is clear that the beatification of our Founder is a celebration of the entire Church that goes beyond the scope of our Salvatorian Family. It is the recognition of the witness of apostolic holiness for all the People of God on the way. However, we cannot deny that the life of our Founder and his Beatification are for us an event of the Spirit of God that has become a way of life and mission. Precisely in this festive setting and as a way of giving thanks for the witness of apostolic holiness of our spiritual Father, the Three branches of the

Salvatorian Family announced a "Year of Thanksgiving for Blessed Francis Jordan" that will begin on July 21, 2021 and will last until July 21, 2022. It will be a time of grace for Salvatorians of all ages, states of life and cultures. We invite you all to be united in a diversity of initiatives that will lead us to deepen our precious apostolic vocation, strengthen our ties of indispensable collaboration and revitalize our humble but firm missionary service in the Church.

#### PROMULGATION OF THE RATIO INSTITUTIONIS SALVATORIANAE

Having passed a long process of discernment, study, writing and rewriting, it was with joy that our General Superior, Fr. Milton Zonta, signed and promulgated, after having obtained the unanimous consent of the General Council, the new version of the "Ratio Formationis Salvatorianae - called to be Apostles of the Divine Saviour". The promulgation took place during the celebration of the First Vespers of the Solemnity of Saint Joseph at the Motherhouse of the Society in Rome. The English version of the Ratio is already available on sds.org publications.



In his reflection on this occasion, Fr. Milton explained that the name of this important document regarding our Salvatorian Formation clearly indicates the formative itinerary proposed much more in a charismatic than in a legal way. It is therefore a matter of showing what the foundation is, the guiding principle of the life and formation of each Salvatorian religious. In this way, this document has a profoundly Salvatorian character, indicating the methodology and content that constitute the identity of the charism of Fr. Francis Jordan, as our model of following Jesus Christ, in the style of the Apostles.

#### WEBINAR ON NEW AMENDMENTS OF FCRA

The IMV along with our auditor's team (Simon Rodrigues & Associates - SRA) organised a Webinar on the 16 March 2021, in order to get updated about the Amendments of FCRA 2020, 12A and other related topics on Finance. The FCRA Amendment Act 2020, has been notified and became effective

from 29 September 2020. Since then, the FCRA department also issued notifications and circulars to give effective to the provision under the amended Act. This will have massive impact on existing functioning of the administration: its structural, operational and even existential areas.

This Webinar helped the members to a great extent to decode and unravel the bill-what the changes could mean to our administration and how we could respond and to be prepared.

#### FORMATION UPDATES

### Philosophy program with Secular Degree in India:

In a context the Don Bosco philosophy College in Warangal decided to provide only two years of philosophy and as a result, for the Secular degree, the candidates will avail the distance education program of IGNO University. Since the university degree is three years, the candidates will begin the academic year during the Spiritual Orientation and completes the degree along with the philosophy. As distance education, the university don't have regular classes except for few days of cluster classes, it is expected not to have further complications. For the batch of 2021-22, the candidates will begin both philosophy (two years' program) and secular degree together and they will complete the final year of the degree after the novitiate during the regency.

### Philosophy program in Sri Lanka:

Due to the travel restrictions and the uncertainty prevailing with the travel plans, the Generalate approved to arrange the philosophy program for the candidates from Sri Lanka for the academic year 2021-22 in Kandy National seminary with the accommodation of the candidates at OMI formation house.
